3. **ADOPTION OF THE MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY 3rd NOVEMBER 2010.**

4. **MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 3rd NOVEMBER 2010.**

- iv) Fence between The Grove and Playing Field – still awaiting quotation from N.L.C maintenance department.
- v) Remembrance Sunday – It was reported that a number of parish councillors attended the service.

5. **SCAWBY RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION** – Correspondence from Scawby Residents Association along with correspondence from ERNLLCA and Mike Wood of N.L.C had previously been circulated to parish councillors.

The Chairman suspended standing orders to allow the members of the public to take part in the debate.

a) Invitation to parish councillors to join the Scawby Brook Residents Association.

IT WAS RESOLVED that councillors could join the Association as individuals, would have

to declare an interest if The Scawby Brook Residents Association was an agenda item, parish councillors who were members of this association could debate any matters relating to the Scawby Brook Residents Association, but would not be able to vote on a proposal put forward.

- b) Request for financial assistance – The parish council noted that they could not provide finance for a third parties legal costs and the possibility of providing finance for the

purpose of research – i.e a flood impact assessment or noise impact assessment was discussed. Parish Council Standing Orders reintroduced to the meeting.

parish council with a statement of their accounts.
